

Recipe Corner Shrimp Pasta Primavera Ingredients

2 tsp minced garlic
1 ½ tsp dill weed
Tsp ground pepper
¼ tsp thyme
8 oz linguine
Pound of shrimp
4 cups assorted veggies
(broccoli, carrots, peas, small
peppers)
1 ½ cups half n half
¼ cup grated parmesan
½ tsp salt
1/3 cup sour cream

Cook pasta in 5 quart pan...add veggies during last few minutes Remove and drain well. Mix half n half, cheese, salt and spices...bring to boil then simmer for five minutes while whisking. I use cooked shrimp briefly sautéed in butter and garlic then add can of sliced mushrooms. Add pasta, shrimp and veggies and sour cream and mix well then heat with very low heat.




