

Recipe Corner

Breakfast Baked Pancake

Bake the bacon for the rendered fat. Start with cold oven and turn the oven to 400 degrees (do NOT open oven) for about 20 minutes. Remove bacon and aluminum sheet making sure some of the fat coats the still hot dish. Keep the dish hot and beat three eggs in a bowl until light. Add 1/2 cup flour, 1/2 cup milk, 1/4 tsp baking powder, 1/2 tsp salt. Pour into the hot dish and bake at 450 degrees for 15 minutes. Turn oven down to 350 degrees to finish until pancake is set. Finish the baked bacon in microwave to desired crispness. Add fresh blueberries, maple syrup or any fruit preserve to pancake. Be very careful and pay attention so you don't grab something that's going to remove your fingerprints.
