S**t on a Shingle (SOS)

For my grandson Shane and all the veterans out there: you'll remember this one.

Ingredients

½ pound ground beef
1-tablespoon bacon fat
(lard/Crisco or butter)
3 tablespoons flour
2 cups whole milk (add
more milk if you want it
thinner)
8 slices of dry toast

Directions

Using a large skillet (12-14 inches), crumble and brown the ground beef with fat and salt. Remove the pan from the heat and let cool slightly. Mix in the flour until all of the meat is covered, using all of the flour. Replace the skillet on the heat and stir in the milk. Keep stirring until the mixture comes to a boil and thickens (boil a minimum of one minute). Serve over the toast. Salt and pepper to taste. LOTS of pepper.

"Fondly" remember this stuff for breakfast at Naval School of Pre-Flight in Pensacola. Served just before the mile swim each morning. You know where most of it wound up.



Book Report




Watched again...still scary as hell. Based on a true story.
