MN Democrats are supporting every anti-ICE protest as real journalists on the internet are finding it to be a smoke screen covering up a huge conspiracy going back decades.

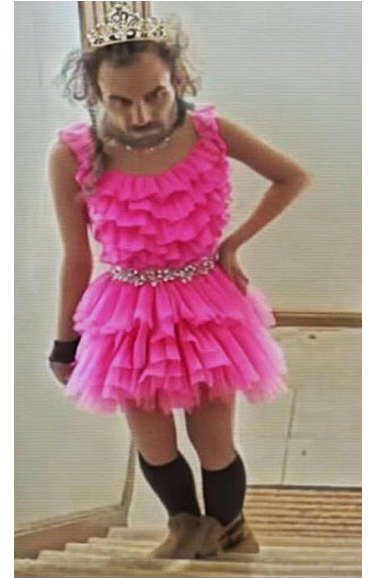

Amy Klobuchar is running for MN governor. She would be the first female governor in state history if she won. She has served in the U.S. Senate for nearly 20 years and is a high-ranking member of the Senate Democratic Caucus.
