


Recipe Corner Honey Glazed Walleye

1 egg
1 teaspoon honey
1 cup coarsely crushed Ritz
1/3 cup all-purpose flour
1/4 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon pepper
4 to 6 walleye fillets
Canola oil

Beat egg and honey. In another bowl, combine the cracker crumbs, flour, salt and pepper. Dip fillets into egg mixture, then coat with crumb mixture. heat 1/4 in. of oil; fry fish over medium-high heat for 3-4 minutes on each side

If the Trump administration imposes regulations on social media and internet giants, it could set a precedent for future Democratic presidents who want to regulate more sectors" he added.


In a separate case, the Obama Justice Department named reporter James Rosen as an unindicted co-conspirator. The Justice Department also seized the phone records of Rosen's parents.

But Hillary isn't.






