Mediterranean Fish Soup

Ingredients

sweet onion, chopped cup chopped peppers, 2 cloves minced garlic 1 can diced tomatoes 4 cups chicken broth 1 can tomato sauce 2 ½ ounce can mushrooms ½ cup orange juice ½ cup dry white wine 2 bay leaves 1 teaspoon dried basil ½ tsp ground black pepper 1 pound medium shrimp peeled and deveined 1 pound fish fillets

Directions

Place onion, sweet peppers, garlic, tomatoes, chicken broth, tomato sauce, mushrooms, orange juice, wine, bay leaves, dried basil and pepper into a slow cooker. Cover and cook on low about four hours. Then stir in shrimp and fish. Cover. Cook 15 to 30 minutes. Remove and discard bay leaves. And, of course, finish the white wine with dinner.


Cause and effect? violence prompts migration and the government blames it on guns?
