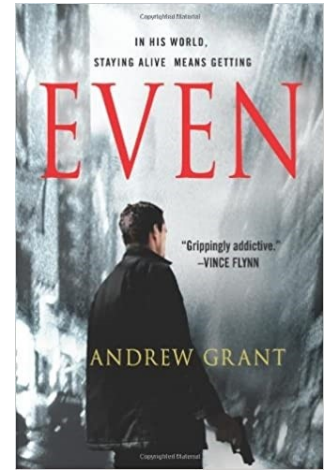
This warning label is not a joke. It was mandated by law. Does that reflect on the mental capacity of today's society or the disdain the law makers have for the governed?
