

Recipe Corner Homemade Chicken Stock This is what's left after a whole chicken is cooked in a crockpot. After pulling the good stuff off the carcass, the remains are then set at low overnight with water up to the brim. Managed to process another two gallons of stock that is so much better than that salty canned stuff. I use freezer bags with two cups in each bag. I use it to cook rice and add it to mashed potatoes. The process is easy though messy and time consuming. Send me an email if you want the recipe. The good stuff is also packed in freezer bags with a bit of the stock with it. I use portions consistent with recipes like the chicken quiche; thawed in refrigerator overnight you'd never know it was frozen. The stock can be added when freezing the good stuff to maintain the flavor and texture of the chicken.


Bon Mots


