



Recipe Corner

Guinness Glazed Corned Beef
Ingredients

- 1 3-5 pound corned beef in pickling liquid and spices
- 1 bottle/can (12+ ounces) Guinness
 - 1 small onion, sliced
 - 1 clove garlic, chopped
 - 1/4 cup brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons grainy mustard
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- salt and pepper to taste

Directions

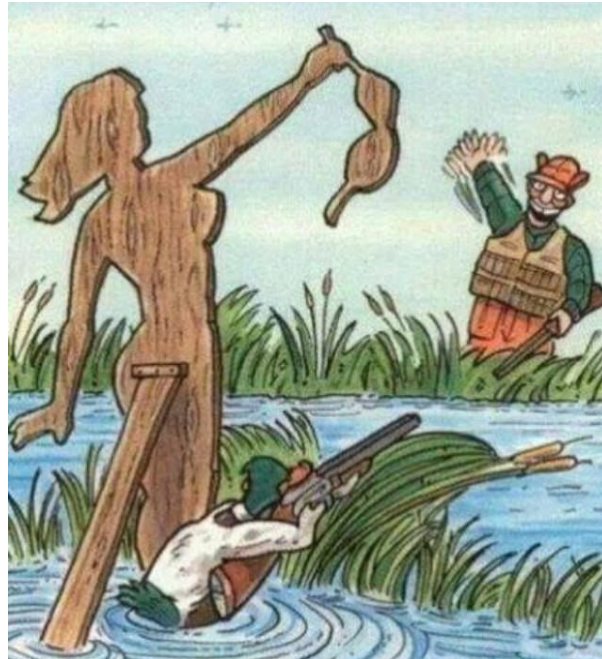
Place the corned beef along with the pickling spices, onion and garlic in a crock-pot, top with the Guinness and cook on low until fork tender, about 8-10 hours. Set the corned beef aside, strain the solids from the Guinness and juices, place the liquid into a large sauce pan, add the brown sugar, mustard, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper, bring to a boil reduce the heat and simmer to reduce by half, about 15-20 minutes. Cut the fat layer from the corned beef, glaze with the Guinness glaze and bake in a preheated 400F oven until the glaze starts bubbling. Leftovers work great for corned beef hash topped with poached eggs:



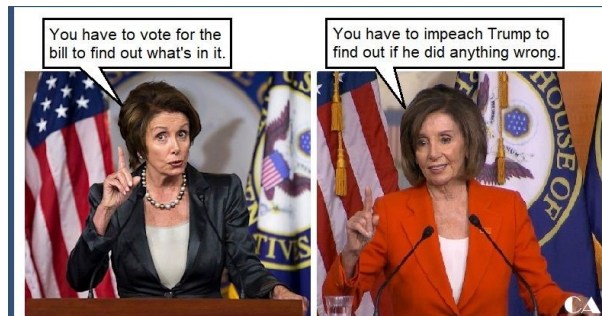

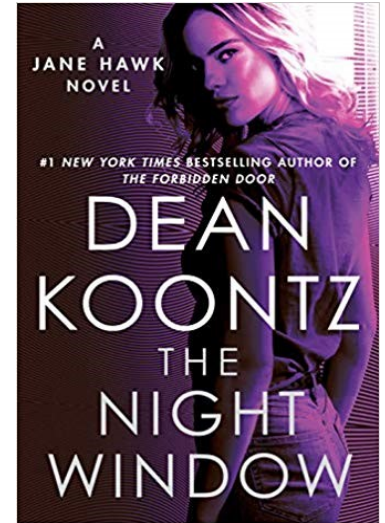
It's duck season. You guys stay safe out there!



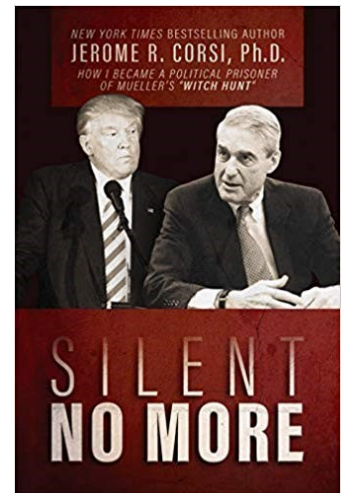

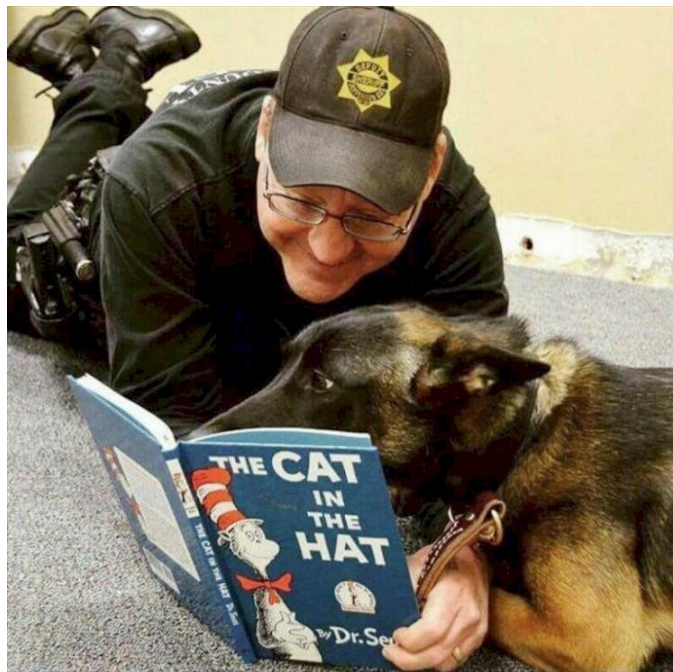


veteran's secret hand signal
