


**Bon Mots**

# **Recipe Corner**

**Crockpot Pinto Beans** 

2 cups pinto beans
(soak overnite to reduce "gas")
4 cups homemade chicken stock
2 slices thick bacon chopped
1/2 cup sweet onion chopped
1/2 cup maple syrup (optional)
Set for 8 hours at low or 4-5 hours on
high. Stir occasionally. Real comfort
food to go with ribs:

## Dry Rub (KC Style ribs)

Two tbl each of salt, sugar, brown sugar, ground cumin, chili powder and cracked black pepper. Add 1 tbl cavenne pepper and 4 tbl paprika. Next; peel membrane from back of ribs; rub spices front and back and wrap in foil; into the refrigerator overnight. Use cookie sheet and place wrapped ribs in oven at 250 degrees for two hours. Open foil and place apple slices and wrap back up...another hour at 250 degrees. At this point you can open the foil and run the oven at 350 degrees for another half hour...or add BBQ sauce and use your grill to finish. I lower the oven to 200 degrees and let them cook wrapped for another two hours. The secret is the dry rub spices overnight and low temp the next day.



My gun research included hundreds of choices. Part of that research included caliber...and at left you can see the many choices. I ordered 95gr .380ACP ammunition and 250 rounds were delivered to my door in just three days without a permit...duh?
