### Lefse

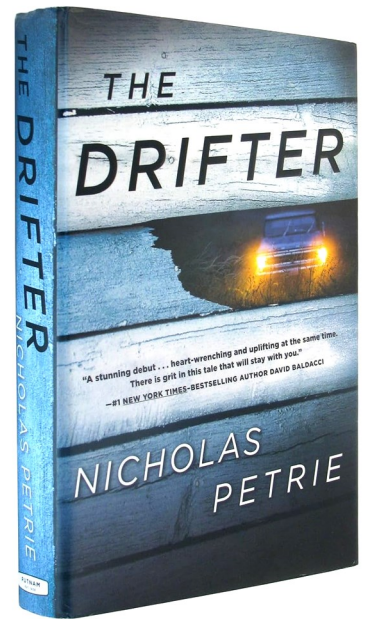
