

Recipe Corner Shepherd Pie (update of one of my favorites)

Ingredients:

brown 1 pound cubed beef frozen mixed vegetables 2 bay leaves crumbled 1/4 cup light cream 1/4 cup sour cream minced garlic 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon pepper 1/4 cup chopped cilantro 2 cups mashed potatoes 2 eggs lots of butter sweet Hungarian Paprika. Directions: Heat oven to 400 degrees. In a 2 quart casserole dish add the vegetables and mix into the meat. Crumble the bay leaf over the mixture. In a small bowl mix the two creams, salt, pepper and parsley and mix into *mashed potatoes. Beat the egg and fold into the potato mixture, spread over the meat and vegetables. Brush the top with the melted butter, sprinkle lightly with paprika. Bake 20 minutes or until top is browned. I also use four cup Pyrex containers and freeze.

*Mashed potato trick: drain the water out of the pot and add four TB butter, the two creams and the minced garlic. Put cover back on make sure ingredients are heated before using a hand beater...this is tricky and easy to burn but worth the extra effort. Be sure to beat the eggs and add them slowly while folding into the potatoes.




Maybe the impeachment circus is designed to keep the public away from the Epstein story? There's a lot of meme traffic on the internet that suggests they have not been successful in burying this story.




