Kitchen Tips and Shortcuts

Always double the amount of garlic in any recipe; fry it in olive oil to turn it from harsh to sweet.

Buy only garlic from Gilroy, TX and beware of China imports.

Never fry bacon, bake it on a sheet with foil in a <u>cold</u> oven turned on to 400°F. for 17 to 20 minutes.

Save the rendered fat in a glass jar in the refrigerator.

Try frying your next steak instead of grilling. Ruth's Steak House in Chicago is famous for it and it works great with cast iron pans.

Sprinkle salt on your cutting board when chopping herbs like parsley or cilantro. Keeps them from flying all over the counter.

Always add at least 2tbs salt when cooking pasta and NEVER olive oil. Save the water for your marinara sauce. Long noodles measured with the diameter of a quarter will give you one 2 oz serving. Wait for the water to boil before adding pasta and use BIG pans of water. A closed fistful of smaller pasta will also give you one 2oz serving.

Last but not least: never wear a white shirt when making marinara sauce.





Book Report


