## **Butter Garlic Shrimp**

## Ingredients

4 tbsp. butter 1 lb. shrimp kosher salt Freshly ground black pepper 4 cloves garlic, minced 3/4 c. dry white wine Juice of 1/2 lemon Rosemary/garlic flakes 3/4 c. grated Parmesan, plus more for garnish 12 oz. cooked angel hair

#### Directions

In a large skillet over medium heat, melt one tablespoon butter. Add shrimp and season with salt and pepper. Cook until pink, two minutes per side. Transfer to a plate. In the same skillet, add remaining butter and garlic. Cook until fragrant, one minute. Add wine, lemon juice, and rosemary; and simmer two minutes, then add Parmesan and parsley and let cook two minutes more. Add cooked angel hair and shrimp and toss until combined.

Of course we used my pasta machine with 'Becca in charge. Hunter fascinated by this computer controlled gadget.

Fun evening and she now has my 2000+ recipe collection for my next challenge.




# 12.16.2023 #413 All the news I see fit to print. Freedom of the press belongs to those who own one.
