

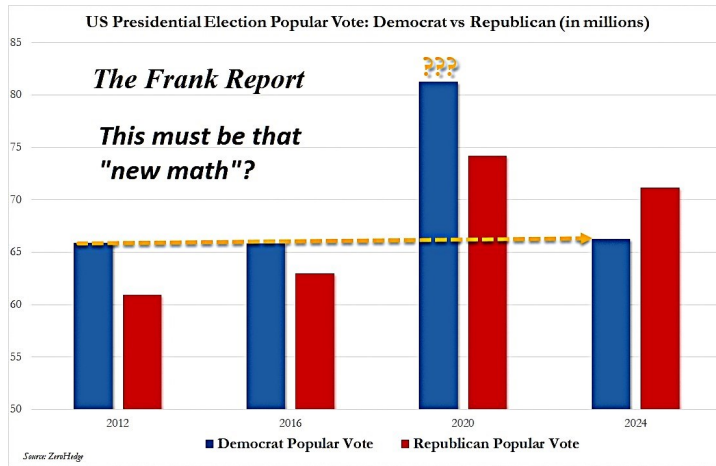

*A conclusion by one of these forensic auditors offered this:*

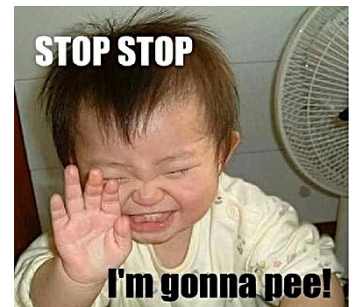
