

Recipe Corner
Cabbage and Ground Beef
Son William h/t for this
one. He likes cabbage but
his mother would accuse
me of spoiling him.

Ingredients

1 lb ground beef
5-6 bacon slices chopped
1 medium cabbage, shredded (about 6-7 cups)
1 large onion, chopped
3-4 cloves minced garlic,
1 teaspoon paprika
½ cup chipped peppers
1 can diced tomatoes
1/2 cup beef broth

Directions

Fry the bacon and then brown the ground beef. Remove the cooked beef from the skillet and set it aside. In the same skillet, add the chopped onion and cook until translucent. Add the paprika and shredded cabbage stirring occasionally, until it's tender and slightly caramelized (about 10-12 minutes). Add the cooked ground beef back into the skillet, along with diced tomatoes and beef broth. Combine and simmer on low. Add a dollop of sour cream when served.

Tip: I prefer the purple cabbage as it's sweeter and easier to shred.
Vidalia onions too.

I use an ulu knife (search for this great kitchen tool).
