Did the whole chicken in a crock pot thingy again. Too large a file so let me know if you want and I'll email separately. Get about two gallons of chicken stock and couple pounds of cooked chicken for later recipes. The stock frozen in two cup freezer bags. Excellent for cooking rice instead of with water. Well worth the effort.

### **NON-FOOD TIP**

Those of you "fortunate" to live where it snows, make sure whoever mounts your snow tires does NOT use the pneumatic drill on the lug nuts. I switch my own but the new tires installed this summer made a typical 20 minute switch evolve into a 90 minute cussing session. The lug nuts should only require 65-87lb ft. I stripped a socket wrench and had to use a pipe wrench on the spare wrench to get the lug nuts off. Two ton jack was only \$20 so I save \$40 switching them as well as avoid the multiple trips since the tires won't fit in the Miata trunk. The Bridgestone Blizzaks snow tires are in their fifth season because of the light weight of the Miata (2200#). Handles great in the snow with its 55/45 weight distribution and still getting almost 40mpg after 165,000 miles and 26 years. Maintenance costs are a lot cheaper than car payments. Taxes and insurance also much lower than anything newer. The grandkids are eyeballing it but I told them I'm going to buried in it!


# Looks like ANTIFA and CODE PINK joined forces.


Facebook censored an image of Santa Claus kneeling before the Baby Jesus — warning that the image "may show violent or graphic content."
