Here's a start on your search:



Probably in that same "lock box" that holds our social security taxes...which would be another interesting search parameter for you...how much is in that mythical lock box and where did it go?



Recipe Corner

While we're on the subject of pizza, I'm teaching my grandkids the four basics of a great pizza: crust, sauce, meat and cheese. First, the crust. It should be crunchy and able to hold the weight of the ingredients when you pick up by the edge. This is possible after the dough (high gluten flour) has absorbed all moisture and has bonded after a 24 period in the refrigerator. Start with warm water, yeast, sugar, salt and olive oil. Mix it and then start adding the flour until a ball forms. Coat with olive oil and seal in a bowl for 24 hours in your refrigerator. Lightly flour countertop and roll the dough into the round or rectangular shape you'll use for baking at 450 degrees until slightly browned. It's now ready for the next stage which I'll provide next week. I'll send the full recipe on request. Better yet, come visit for a hands on tutorial. Bring wine, Chianti, of course.
