

Recipe Corner Pork Loin in Crockpot One of the loins from the freezer (mentioned in newsletter 2.11.2023) was used in this recipe. Four loins with three meals from each comes out to about a buck a meal. Ingredients 1 (2 pound) pork tenderloin 1 (1 ounce) dry onion bits 1 cup water ¾ cup red wine 3 tablespoons soy sauce 3 tablespoons minced garlic freshly ground black pepper Directions

Place pork tenderloin and soup mix in a slow cooker. Pour water, wine, and soy sauce on top, turning pork to coat. Carefully spread garlic over pork, leaving as much on top as possible. Sprinkle with pepper. Cover and cook on Low for 4 hours or until the internal temperature reaches 145 degrees F (63 degrees C). Remove pork from the slow cooker and let rest for 10 minutes. Slice and serve with cooking liquid as au jus. I add small boiled potatoes

cut in half in the au jus but mashed potatoes works.

But wait, there's more ...


