**Recipe for Disaster**

The 2022 election will be the key factor in this recipe. There are 36 democrats and 30 republicans not up for senate election until 2024. Maybe because we don't have one?

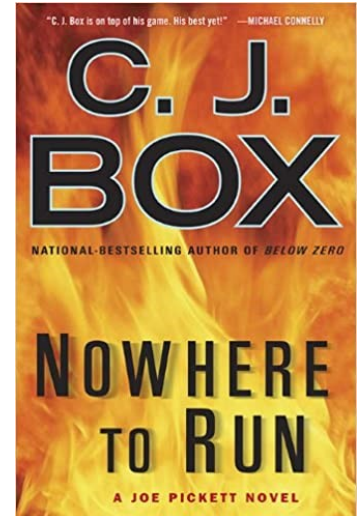

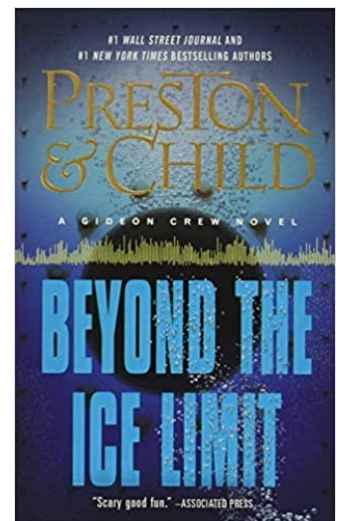

It's **Joe Pickett**...enough to justify the time reading. C.J. Box is a master at plot construction and character integrity from book to book. Highly recommend.

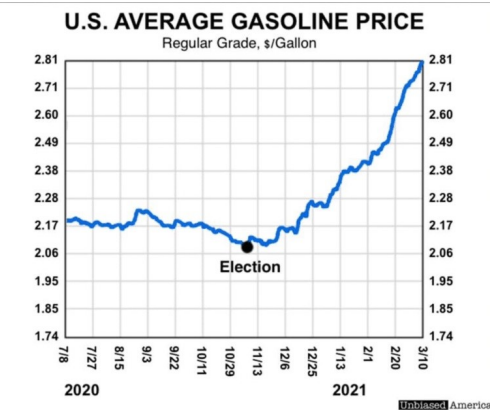

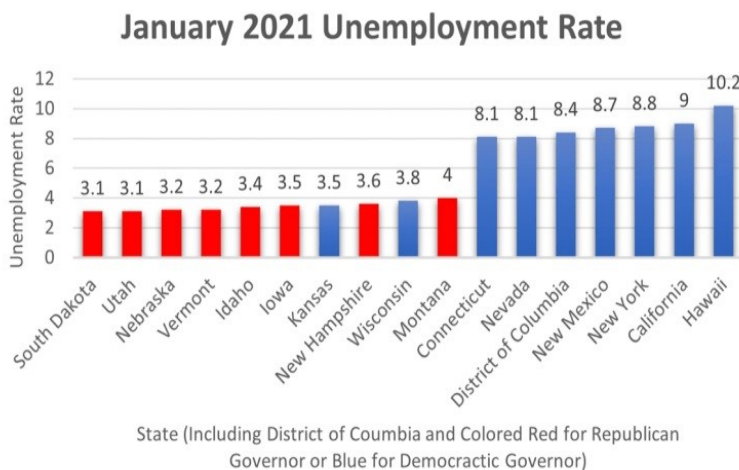


The city of Minneapolis will pay \$27 million to settle a lawsuit by the family of George Floyd over his death in police custody, a case that stirred national protests over racial injustice and police brutality. At the same time, only half the jurors had been selected for the trial that would finally provide details of just how and why “poor George” died. **Great idea...can I carry a gun for the same reason?**

Despite bare shelves and back orders of up to a year, gun sales continued to soar last month as more people sought personal protection and got ahead of the coming gun control wave from the Biden administration and a liberal Congress. The FBI said that its background check tally of 3,442,777 was the highest February count ever and followed January’s 4,314,804 monthly record over the 24-year-old system. In just two months, there have been nearly as many background checks than for each of the first seven years of the National Instant Criminal Background Check System. Last year also saw a growing pattern of first-time buyers, especially minorities. The group said, “NSSF estimates that 8.4 million people bought a firearm for the first time in 2020. That’s 40% of all purchases. This year’s buyer is increasingly diverse too. Forty percent of 2020’s buyers were women and the biggest increase of any demographic category was among African Americans, who bought guns at a rate 58% greater than in 2019.”
