

Recipe Corner Calzones For the calzone dough: 3/4 cup lukewarm water 1 teaspoon active dry yeast 2 cups bread flour 1 1/2 teaspoons salt 1 tablespoon olive oil Work the dough like a pizza dough. For the spinach-ricotta filling: 2 tablespoons olive oil 1 medium onion, diced 3 cloves garlic, minced 1/2 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper 6 ounces baby spinach 1/2 cup ricotta cheese 1/2 cup shredded mozzarella 1/2 cup tomato sauce Heat the oil in a large skillet. Add spinach (in batches if needed) and toss until wilted, about 1 minute. Remove from the heat and let cool. Add the ricotta and mozzarella and combine. Can spinach works and I add cooked Italian sausage. Directions:

Divide dough into 8 pieces. Roll out and use about two TBS of filling over sauce on the 6-8 inch circle. Fold over and press edge with fork to seal. Brush with egg wash and cut 2-3 slits. 450° oven for 15-20 minutes on parchment paper.



Freeze unbaked calzones in single layer on a baking sheet. Transfer to zip-top bag and freeze for up to 3 months. To cook frozen calzones bake at 400°F for 30 minutes or until the filling reaches 160°F. Kudos to Granddaughter Gracie



President proposes to suspend the payroll tax. Democrats complain it only affects people who are working and have jobs. Think about that for a moment.




