34 cup uncooked wild rice
 2 tbs butter
 4 cups chicken broth
 1 can cream of mushroom
 soup
 1 can undrained sliced

¼ cup diced celery¼ cup diced onion1 cup half and half

mushrooms

Place all but the half and half in crock pot.
Cook on high four hours stirring occasionally, then the half and half about 15 minutes before serving.
(just enough to heat)

Add any of the following: cubed ham, chicken, turkey or bacon (all cooked).

Yes, it does freeze...just add a bit more half and half.

And please, use your homemade chicken broth, not that salt preserved water in a can they sell as food. One fryer chicken will give you a gallon of broth as well as the chicken for this recipe.


