

Recipe Corner Beer Batter for Fish

With fishing season on the horizon, here's my favorite Walleye beer batter:

Ingredients

- 1 cup flour
- 2 teaspoons salt
- 1 teaspoon garlic salt
- 1 teaspoon lemon pepper
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 cup beer
- 1 or 2 eggs, as desired

Directions

- Combine eggs and beer, then mix in dry ingredients. Stir. Batter is too thick if it sticks to a finger without dripping slightly, too thin if it runs off. Add more beer or more flour.
- Prepare fillets by cutting them in half. Important: Dry them on paper towels so the batter sticks to them. Dip fish in batter.
- Using oil of your choice, deep fry until golden brown (either in a deep fryer or deep skillet).
- Batter won't spoil and can be reused if refrigerated. "The next day when you look at it in the refrigerator, it won't look very good, but just stir it, again adding more beer or flour as necessary for desired thickness."

In his latest attempt to raise his national profile, MN Gov. Tim Walz took shots at FL Gov. Ron DeSantis saying DeSantis's state is "where freedom goes to die."

The remarks were made during an event to promote reading month, where Walz unveiled a Little Free Library outside of his office.

DeSantis said recent Florida legislation is designed to prohibit "pornography and sexual material in the classroom."

This may include books such as Toni Morrison's "The Bluest Eye," which contains graphic sexual content, including depictions of sexual assault and molestation, according to the nonpartisan BookLooks.org.

The book is available in Walz's library.

"This Little Free Library is one way we're doing our part to ensure books remain accessible to teach, tell our story, and inspire the next generation of readers in Minnesota," he added.

Another book available in the MN governor's library, "Melissa" tells the story of a fourth-grade boy who transitions to being a girl.

USA Today named Rep. Leigh Finke, a biological male who identifies as a woman, Minnesota's "Woman of the Year".

"I have a future-oriented vision of what the work is, that is how I think of it. I think about what we're doing for our children's sake, for the next generation, for 30 years from now," said Finke, the first transgender lawmaker in the Minnesota House.
