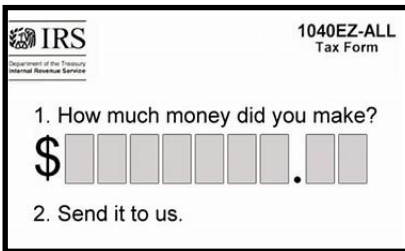




Recipe Corner
Polo Relleno

Beat hell out of several chicken breasts until they are flat. Combine 1/3 cup cornmeal and taco seasoning (let your taste buds determine how much). Sprinkle cilantro, black pepper and salt on the chicken. Cut sweet peppers into strips to fit on the flat chicken pieces. Add a slice of cheese (*I use Provolone – Monterey Jack or Swiss also works*). Roll the chicken up and skewer with wet toothpicks. Beat an egg...dip the rolled up chicken in it. Roll the egg-wet chicken in the cornmeal/taco mix. Place seam side down in greased baking dish. Sprinkle some of the cornmeal/taco mix on it. Bake in a 375 degree oven for about half an hour. Serve with Dos Equis or Cervantes or tequila!

OK, Spanish rice works too. Got a great recipe for that.

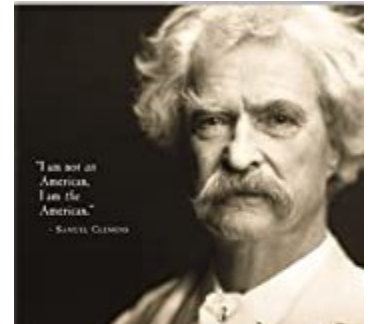

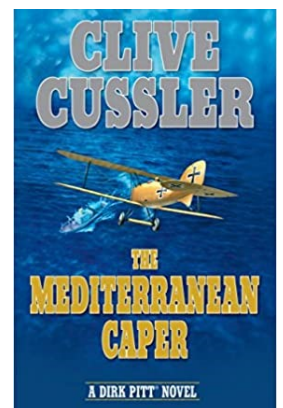

Book Report

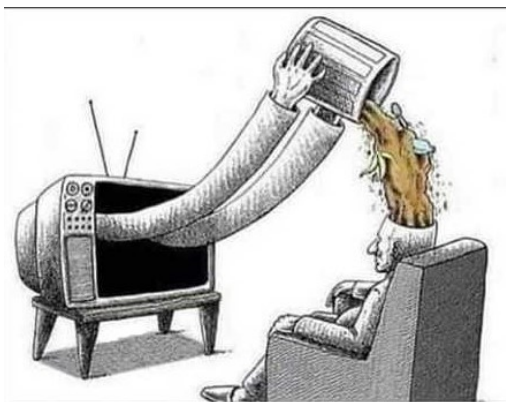
