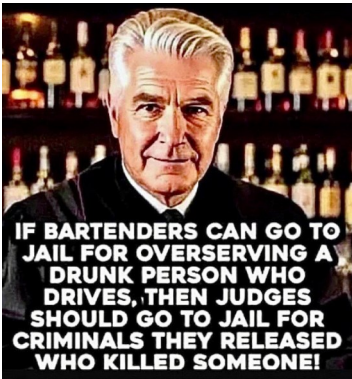

Steve Grove is the publisher and CEO of the Minnesota Star Tribune (formerly the Minneapolis Star Tribune). He served as a commissioner in the Walz administration. The paper is owned by Glen Taylor. 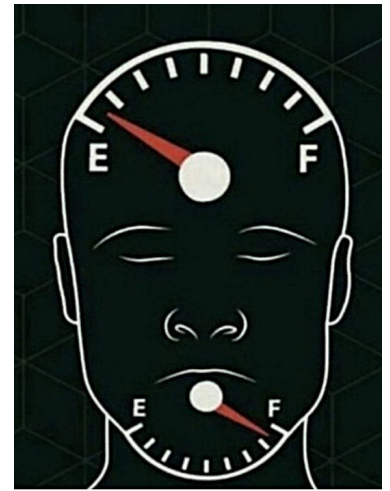
Here's his rationale:

BTW...here's a reminder:

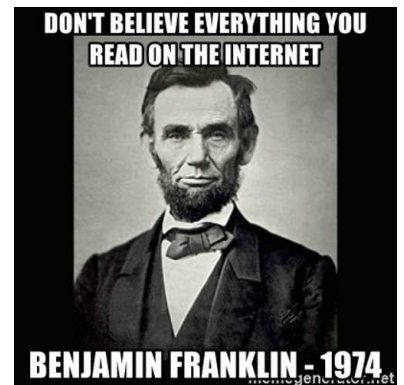
Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of . . . or abridging the freedom of speech, or of the press. . .
