Most men don't want to reach for the good ones because they are afraid of falling and getting hurt. Instead, they just take the rotten apples from the ground that aren't as good, but easy.



Biden's administration announced a plan to try to protect bureaucrats from being fired by the second Trump administration.



The net interest on the federal debt exceeded defense spending in the first half of fiscal year 2024 as government spending and interest rates remain high, according to the Congressional Budget Office.

Net interest on the U.S. government's public debt cost an estimated \$440 billion in the first half of fiscal year 2024 from October to March, compared to \$308 billion in the same period in fiscal year 2023, an increase of 43%, according to the CBO. Medicare and Medicaid were both exceeded by payments in interest, with the programs costing \$389 billion and \$304 billion.

Social Security remained the biggest source of spending, increasing from \$652 billion in the first six months of fiscal year 2023 to \$711 billion this year, a gain of around 9%, according to the CBO. Excuse my French but you assholes at CBO better realize that Social Security is money you took from us and we expect to get it back!

The nationwide average price for regular gas hit a six-month high of \$3.60 a gallon spiking more than 50 percent under Biden. Joe can't dump ther Strategic Reserves so how about knocking off the taxes we pay for gas?

The Supreme Court struck down Biden's program to grant student loan forgiveness to roughly 40 million Americans using executive power in June 2023. 

Let's take a quick look at the Department of Education.
