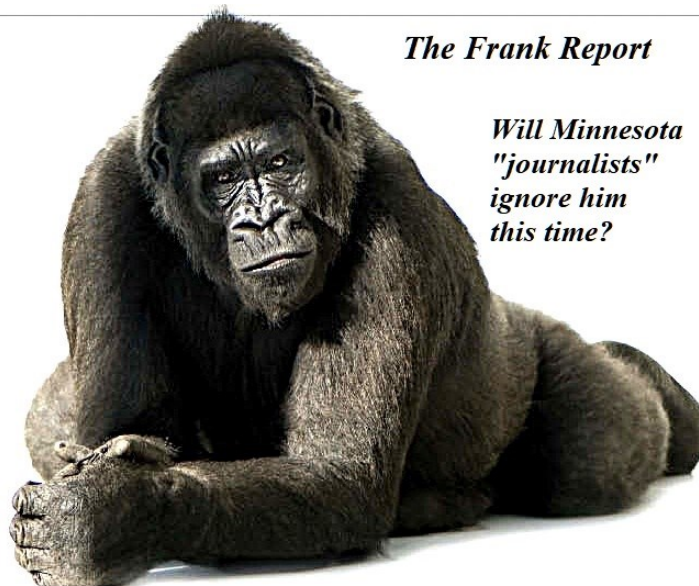


*It's time to stop this lawfare crap!*

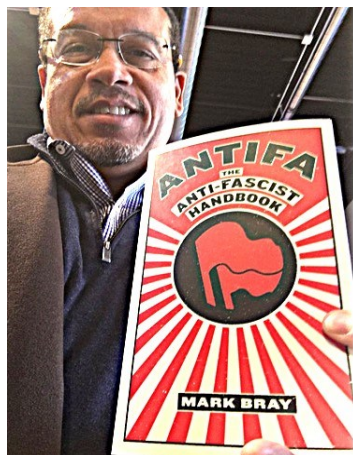

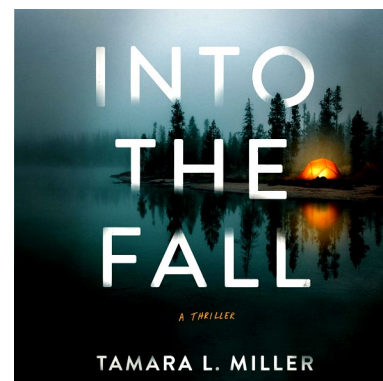
The scandal, known as Feeding Our Future, after a nonprofit at the center of the case, involved the theft of \$250 million from government programs meant to feed low-income children.

DOGE revealed that three deep-blue states, California, New York, and Massachusetts, were responsible for \$305 million, or 80%, of the \$382 million in fraudulent unemployment payments issued since 2020.
