

Recipe Corner

First...you cannot grow toilet paper and no, I don't know how long toilet paper will last if you freeze it.

Marinara Sauce Two cans of diced tomatoes One can tomato paste Two TBS minced garlic **TBS Basil flakes** Three TBS Olive oil TBS sugar Use about three TBSP olive oil and add about twoTBSP minced garlic...key is to sauté the garlic so it becomes sweet but be careful not to burn the olive oil (*it has low burn temp*). Puree the tomato and paste; then into the pan. Sprinkle basil and sugar and stir. Simmer on very low heat; covered pan. Dash of red wine works well too. I freeze this sauce in two cup containers...you can even use zip lock bags. Great for a quick meal using cooked Italian sausage or hamburger mixed with the sauce and then over any pasta. Tip on pasta: ignore recipes

that tell you to use olive oil during or after cooking the pasta. If you do that, the sauce won't stick to the pasta. Any Italian grandma would smack you for doing that! This is also an excellent sauce for pizza and calzones; Just ask Gracie!



For example, (*as of 4.2.2020*) MN population: 5,611,179 with China flu 742 cases and 18 deaths. The seasonal flu has 762 cases and 58 deaths. During the 2009-2010 H1N1 virus, it wasn't called an emergency even though 61 million US infected with 275,000 hospitalized and 13,000 deaths. No shelter in place nor mandatory closings of schools and businesses. Even the lame stream media refrained from their current porn panic.

More number crunching:

The average number of deaths per year, *worldwide*, due to the seasonal flu virus, is around 470,000. The total number of Wuhan virus deaths as of 4.2.2020, as reported by the World Health Organization, 52,774. The number of flu deaths in the U.S. in the 2017-18 flu season, 61,000; and the number of Wuhan deaths so far in the U.S., as reported yesterday by the Centers for Disease Control, 5,808.

Going back in my memory of the polio pandemic, the unknown was the fear factor. Until Jonas Salk's vaccine, we had some of the self-isolation for controlling its spread. The modeling being used to track the China flu is the same kind of modeling being used for climate change...how's that for creating doubt.
