

Recipe Corner Mexican Lasagna

Ingredients

1 pound lean ground beef 2 sweet peppers, chopped 1 onion, chopped 2 cloves garlic, minced 2 tbs taco seasoning 1 cup salsa 3 large flour tortillas 2 cups shredded cheese

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 F.

In a large skillet, brown the ground beef.

Add the sweet pepper and onions and cook until they begin to soften.

Add the garlic and taco seasoning. Stir well.

Stir in the salsa, set aside.

In a round baking dish or deep dish pie plate, add one of the tortillas.

Add half of the beef in an even layer, then top with ¹/₃ of the cheese.

Cover the first layer with a second tortilla, add the remaining beef, and half the remaining cheese.

Top with the last tortilla and the remaining cheese.

Bake for 20-30 minutes or until the cheese on top is melted and the edges of the tortillas are crisp.

Remove from the oven and allow to sit for 5 minutes before cutting.





The Democratic-controlled MN Legislature in 2023 made undocumented immigrants eligible for MinnesotaCare — the state's health insurance program for the working poor — as of Jan. 1, 2025. Nearly 17,400 undocumented people have enrolled in MinnesotaCare.
