ROAST BEEF AU POIVRE

That's a five pound eye round roast.
Roselee never trusted me with any
recipe ingredient that cost more than
a dollar a pound. Interesting that the
more you pay for a cut of meat like
this one, the simpler the recipe.

Here's what I did:

Shallow pan...spray with vegetable oil...place sheet of aluminum foil and spray that (saves on cleaning time later). Rub the cut sides with salt and garlic buds. Sprinkle cracked pepper on counter and roll the roast to coat. Pat the pepper into the meat. Place roast in the pan fat side up. Preheat oven at 450 degrees and cook for 15 minutes...then turn oven down to 325 degrees and add a cup of water to the pan. Allow 20 minutes cook time per pound or 140 degrees temperature for medium rare. My new oven has a gadget that plugs into the oven inside with a probe you stick into the roast. Touch screen monitors the temp and also provides convection cooking for roasting vice baking. However, with the preheat step, I used an external probe instead because I couldn't figure out how to plug it in while at that high temp without adding a new burn scar on my hand. Used the juices in the pan to baste the roast a few times and managed not to burn myself doing that. Took it out just shy of the 140 degrees since it keeps cooking after

you take it out.
Then I made the sauce:
3/4 c. sour cream
1 tbs horseradish
1/4 tsp. brown mustard
Dash of sugar
1/3 cup pan juices

Yes, next week I'll have a recipe for roast beef hash for the leftovers.



In case you missed this: Disney has taken control of HULU...probably going to ruin it like they did ESPN?


Bon Mots
