#### oven baked lamb chops

Garlic bits, cilantro and olive oil on each side. Bake in a 350 degree oven for about 15 minutes which will give you a pink center.

Anything beyond that and they get a gamey taste.

The baked potato to go with it is scored once lengthways then three times sideways. Into microwave about five minutes, then into the 350 oven until done. Use the last 15 minutes to add the lamb chops. A salad and some wine and you're good to go.




