


Recipe Corner Banana Pound Cake (great with ice cream)

package yellow cake mix 4 eggs\* (room temperature) 1/3 cup oil 1/2 cup water about 4 medium mashed bananas package instant vanilla pudding 1/2 teaspoon cinnamon 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg 1 teaspoon vanilla

Combine all ingredients in large mixer bowl. Mix until blended, then beat at medium speed for 4 minutes. Turn batter into greased and *lightly floured*\* 10 inch Bundt pan. Bake in 350 degree oven for an hour. \*tips: use some of the cake mix to flour and you'll get a nice finish on the top; also crack the eggs on a flat surface (not edge of bowl) and the shell will stay stuck to the membrane so no shell fragments.






"Reverend" Al Sharpton has a history of involvement with racism...search any of the four below for details (*not to mention how the IRS ignores the taxes he owes*).
