

Recipe Corner Beef Marinade

5 large garlic cloves
1 teaspoon salt
1/4 cup dry red wine
1/4 cup balsamic vinegar
1/4 cup orange juice
1 tablespoon soy sauce
1 teaspoon honey or sugar

Ziplock bag for at least two hours at room temperature. This breaks down the fiber in the beef so cheap cuts become as tender as more expensive cuts.

Beef bottom round is my favorite as they can be cut ½ to ¾ inches thick. Don't remove the fat…it makes great smoke when you're grilling and adds to the flavor.

Notice the cleaver...from Chicago Cutlery so it holds an edge better than most knives. Great hand control and sharp enough to slice tomatoes so thin: only one side.

Social media platform Twitter is testing a new feature that shows users a message urging them to read the article linked in a tweet before retweeting it to their own followers.




Book Report

During the year between the summers of 2018-2019, the Minneapolis Police Department (MPD) was *unable* to Immediately respond to 6,776 priority one calls. A priority one call can involve a shooting, rape, or domestic assault in progress. The city government says its "objective is to have a squad en route to a priority one event within 70 seconds of receipt by the dispatcher." MPD requested 400 new officers in September 2019. Mayor Frey asked the council for 14 additional officers – three in traffic, three in investigations and eight beat cops. The MPLS council gave them four...4...single digit four. Chicago has 44.2 officers per 10K population. Mpls has 22.8 per 10K population...with 880 officers and 229 "other" employees. Seven quit today.
