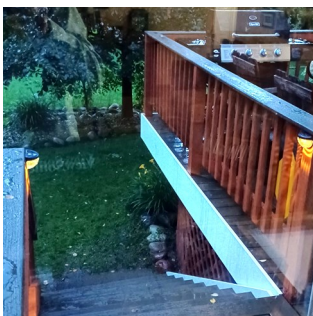
*You growing Pot?*

*Now I get to play with solar lights for the deck.*

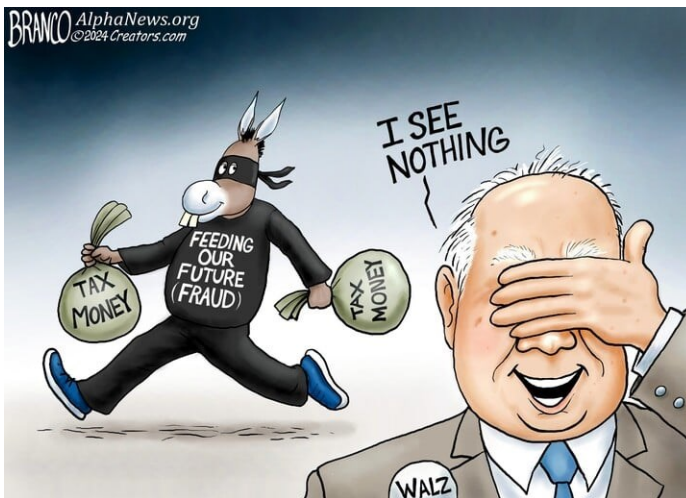

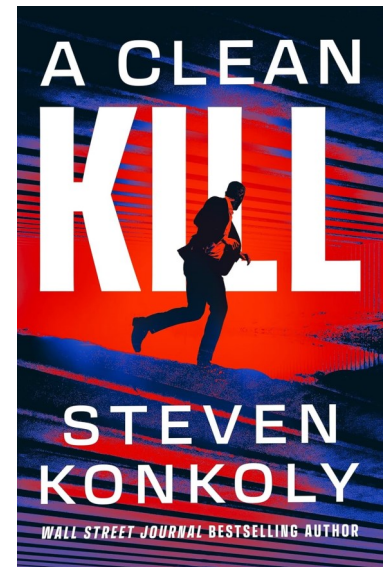

State auditors could confirm eligibility for only 60% of Minnesotans who participated in a \$500 million frontline worker bonus program. 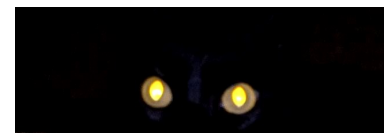

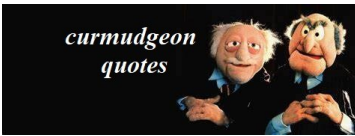


### Book Report
