

Recipe Corner WTHH* Cake (*what the hell happened?)

This was supposed to be a sour cream Bundt cake.
2/3 cup chopped pecans
2 tablespoons brown sugar
1-1/2 teaspoons cinnamon
1 cup butter, softened
2 cups sugar
2 eggs

1/2 teaspoon Vanilla Extract
2 cups all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon baking powder
1/4 teaspoon baking soda
1/4 teaspoon salt
1 cup (8 ounces) sour cream

Directions

Preheat oven to 350°. Combine pecans, brown sugar and cinnamon; set aside. Cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in vanilla. Combine flour, baking powder, baking soda and salt; add to creamed mixture alternately with sour cream, beating well after each addition. Pour half of the batter into a greased and floured 10-in. fluted tube pan; sprinkle with half of the pecan mixture. Top with remaining batter and pecan mixture. Bake 45-50 minutes. Cool 10 minutes.



Recipe picture looked good.




