Jack Smith is the latest of the DOJ "warriors" sent by US attorney general Merrick Garland as an independent special counsel in November 2022. Jack is in charge of two ongoing criminal investigations by the DOJ of Donald Trump, one into his involvement in the "attack" on the US Capitol on January 6 and the other into the "improper" handling of classified information. Jack Smith's wide-ranging investigation has cost taxpayers over \$9 million since he was appointed.

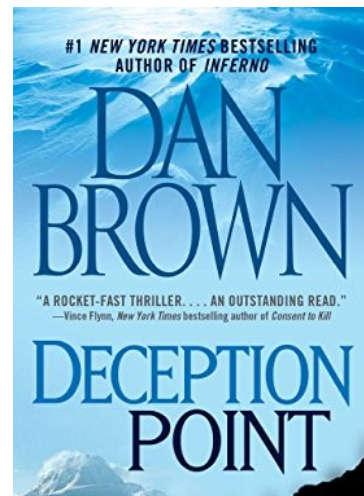
In comparison, John Durham's investigation into the origins of the controversial FBI Crossfire Hurricane probe cost about \$1 million in the same time period. It ended in May after releasing a significant, 300-page report that faulted the FBI's leadership for approving the investigation into Mr. Trump—although no charges were filed against any employees at the FBI or DOJ and no one was fired.

Special counsel Robert Mueller's probe, which ultimately did **not** reveal that Mr. Trump colluded with the Russian government, cost a whopping \$32 million upon its conclusion.

U.S. Magistrate Judge Bruce Reinhart, (*a donor to Barack Obama and Jeb Bush who once represented employees of Jeffrey Epstein and authorized the federal raid on Mar-a-Lago*) has handed down a gag order prohibiting Donald Trump from disclosing information to the press and public...

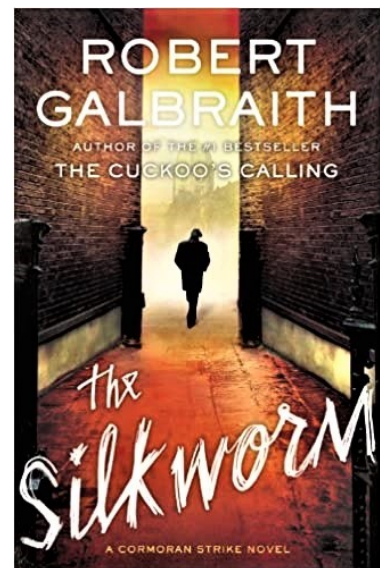

For fiscal year 2022, the IRS collected \$4.26 trillion in net taxes, up from \$2.76 trillion in fiscal year 2020, the final year Trump was in office. The national debt is at \$32 TRILLION and rising. Politicians are eyeing cuts in Social Security and Medicare. Meanwhile, the Social Security Administration sent \$4.48 billion to the Kiev government in 2022 and 2023. USAID paid off \$4.5 billion worth of Ukraine's sovereign debt through payments made to the World Bank. Western financial interests including BlackRock Inc. are the largest holders of Ukrainian bonds. Evanston, Illinois, is paying out \$10 million over the course of a decade to black residents as part of a reparations for past housing discrimination, as well as their descendants. Not to be outdone, the California Reparations Task Force voted in favor of approving \$800 billion.

Chicago Police statistics show a 39% increase in total crime this year compared to the prior year. And the answer for the 'defund the police' crowd is to spend \$30 million on the recently launched Illinois "Peacekeepers Program." A man wearing a neon "Peacekeeper" vest was arrested for brutally beating and robbing a motorist in a Chicago neighborhood. Police surveillance video, showed officers apprehending the suspect while fleeing the scene and trying to take the "Peacekeeper" vest off.

The Veterans Administration has a backlog of roughly 250,000 cases. Sen. Marsha Blackburn (R-TN) noted that the VA Mission Act, signed in 2019, was intended to increase access to veteran care in their local area. Blackburn said that receiving access to direct primary care can take up to 75 days in Tennessee for an initial appointment.

The Biden administration's director of Health and Human Services (HHS) has threatened to pull Medicare funding from providers who refuse to offer "transgender" mutilating surgeries and cross-sex hormones.

Democrat Grace Napolitano of California announced this weekend that she will retire when this term ends in January 2025. She will be 88. Grace went from being poor when she entered Congress after the 1998 election to a net worth of over \$5 million. This coincided with the national debt rising from under \$6 trillion when she arrived to more than \$32 trillion today. While many members of Congress whose wealth explodes while they oversee federal spending and regulate the companies they invest in, Grace was exceptionally good at increasing her net worth.

Genetically modified mosquitoes have been released by a company called Oxitec, funded by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, to fight multiple diseases including Dengue fever, yellow fever and Zika. The first cases of malaria in 20 years in Florida and California were blamed on Gates.
