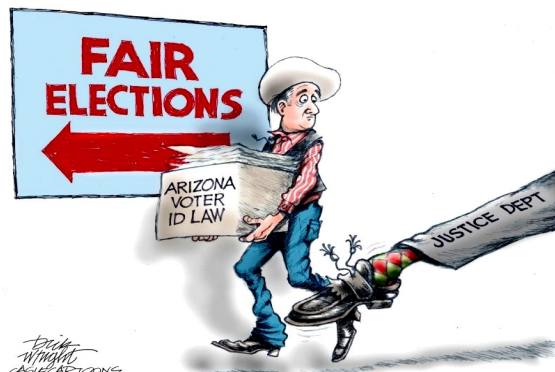


An editor of a 'major news outlet' is advising the media not to use the now iconic image of Trump defiantly raising his fist after the attempt on his life this weekend.
