


Recipe Corner Pecan Encrusted Fish Ingredients:

1/2 cup dry breadcrumbs
2 tablespoons finely
chopped pecans
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
1/4 teaspoon black pepper
1/2 cup low-fat buttermilk
1/2 teaspoon hot sauce
3 tablespoons flour
4 (6 ounce) fish fillets
Directions:

Combine breadcrumbs, pecans, salt, garlic, and pepper in a shallow dish. Combine buttermilk and hot sauce (such as Tabasco) in a medium bowl. Place flour in a third dish. Dredge fillets in flour, dip into buttermilk mixture, then into breadcrumb mixture. Heat 1 1/2 tsp oil in a large skillet over mediumhigh heat. Cook fillets for three minutes on each side or until fish flakes easily. Serve fish with lemon and beer with lime.


Book Report
