### Cashew Chicken

#### Ingredients:

chicken breast cut into small cubes  
cashew nuts  
peppers, cut into small square pieces  
fresh ginger or powder  
onion cut into small square pieces

#### Marinate: (for each serving)

1sp baking soda  
1 teaspoon corn starch  
1/2 teaspoon rice wine

#### Sauce: (for each serving)

1/2 tablespoon oyster sauce  
3/4 teaspoon soy sauce  
3 tablespoons water  
3 dashes white pepper powder  
1/2 teaspoon sugar  
1/2 teaspoon rice wine  
1/8 teaspoon sesame oil

Marinate the chicken meat with the baking soda for 15-20 minutes and then rinse the chicken thoroughly. Pat the chicken meat dry with paper towels and then marinate with rice wine and corn starch for 15 minutes. Stir fry the chicken with 1 tb of oil and set aside. Stir fry peppers, onions and ginger with another tb oil. Add the chicken meat and cashew nuts and stir. Add the sauce and stir until the chicken meat is cooked and well coated. Serve hot with steamed white rice...and Saki, of course.  
*Note: This is the basic recipe. Experiment! Careful with peppers...the green ones give Margaret heartburn.*

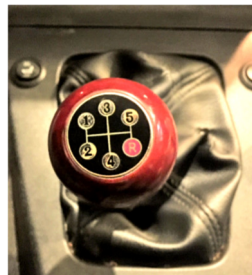

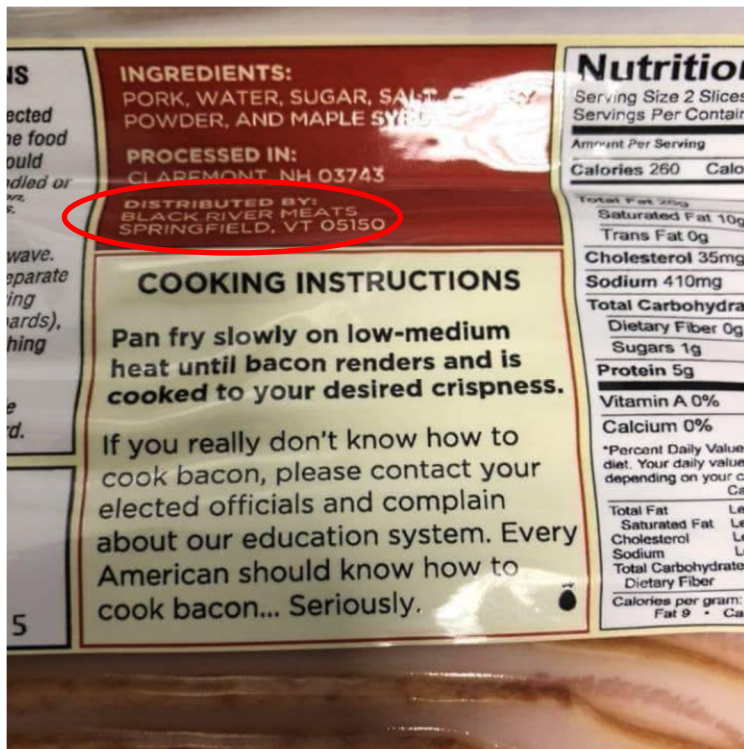

**\*Does anyone think maybe they will finally hire a few Republicans?**

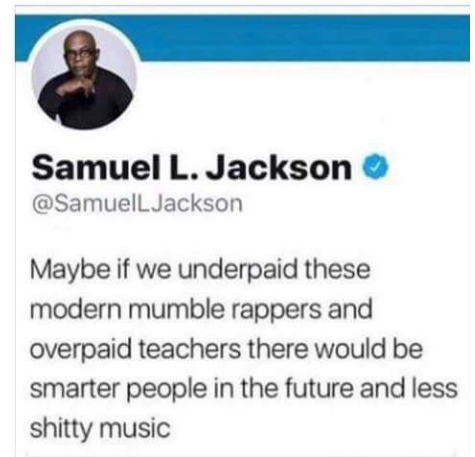
