


Recipe Corner

I haven't EVER heard from the congress critter whose picture is at top of this column...let alone voted for her.



I'm at the tail end of the dozen books by Clive Cussler in the *Isaac Bell* series. The attention to detail and amazing facts about the early 20th Century is worth the read. You also get tight plots and unforgettable characters.
