

Every branch of the US military *except the Marine Corps* has failed to meet their recruitment goals. We are low on ammo, as the commander-in-chief pointed out, as well as soldiers. 

Dr. Francis Collins, previously the NIH Director, and Dr. Tony Fauci, former NIAID Director, made substantial profits from royalty checks during the Covid pandemic.
