

Recipe Corner Shredded beef w/gravy

(experimenting again)

Crock pot: chopped onion, sweet peppers and garlic bits. Then round of eye beef slices marinated overnight in red wine and orange juice. Low setting for about five hours until you can easily tear the meat apart. Corn starch w/water. Cook about another hour then add cooked mushrooms. Serve over or alongside mashed potatoes. 
(NOTE: this is NOT my usual sarcasm...these are actual facts.)




Book Report

But, wait...there's more!


