


## **Recipe Corner**



Working on landscaping lighting. Figured a way to add LED spotlights for flag. Had to work backwards since access to the wiring meant taking the existing light apart and figure out how to wire the new spotlight. Navy flag there too so thanks to their electronics classes that I could figure it out. Five led lights in a soft white (3000K) for a total of 35 watts...less than what an indoor night light with standard bulb uses.








Step one is to clean all the bugs off. Then remove the existing light. Take all the clamps off and pull the wires out. There's usually a foot or more not required. The wire for the LED light is 22 braded gauge so best to solder it before using the connectors to get all the wires together so they can fit back into the box. I also wrap the 22 gauge wire with electricians tape for added support. Clean the old light and attach. Turn on the switch and if everything works (and there's no smoke), use clear silicone caulk to further protect from the weather.
