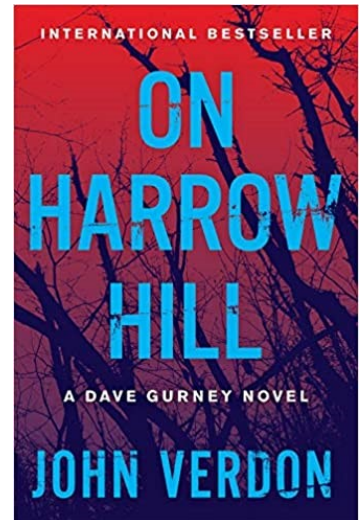

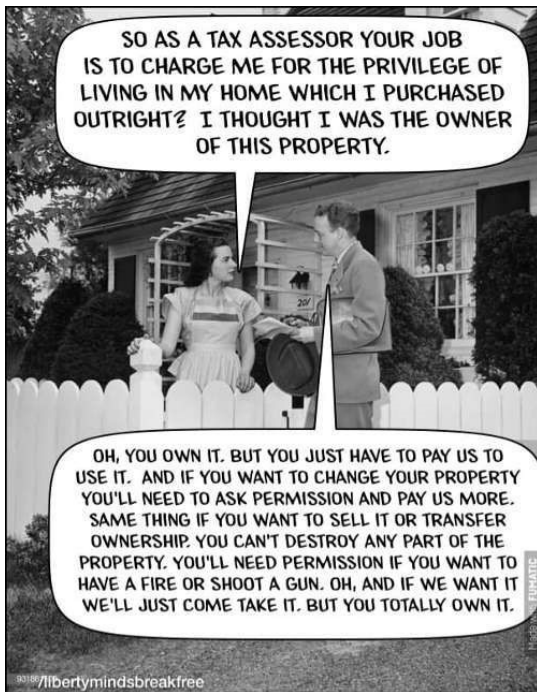


In Vino Veritas

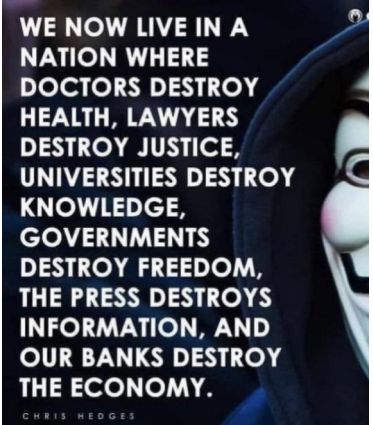
The conversation at left will explain things as only a bureaucrat can. Sounds like a giant HOA scheme to me! Weird
