I did not know that President Trump is responsible for the hurricane threatening the East Coast. The Democrats want my money to impeach him.


I did not know that the Democrats have been paying Russian spies to destroy our way of life. The Republicans want my money to build a wall around California.


Here's the plan:

Another project completed...never liked the cabinet at left. Components wouldn't fit and storage was inaccessible. Chris borrowed Brenda's truck and we hauled lumber I calculated I would need to build something that would match the speakers I built several decades ago (*Wharfedale 120's for you aficionados...with Bose 10's from Susan for the rear surround sound*).

Used select pine 2x2's for the frame and 3/4 inch 8'x10" solid oak for the top. Kreg joinery using over 120 screws made for a solid fit. Using a plan from between my ears and measurements of the components, I had to work upside down and backwards. Father's day gift from Margaret and Larry was a belt sander that prevented previous frustration using palm sander for a smooth finish.





Golden Oak stain with three coats of polyurethane and it was ready to move from the garage to the lower level. Took Chris, Brenda and me to move it.



Found storage baskets and CD's I forgot I had to separate classical, jazz and pop to match my mood. Added a center speaker that picks up the mid and high frequencies and my hearing aids work great with the new setup. TV programs now delivered in HD using HDMI cables and a Sherwood amplifier.



Everything fits and everything works. That's a 50" TV on top. On right is a Panasonic CD player that holds 25 CD's. Middle is a DVD player and ROKU for streaming TV programs. At left is the Sherwood amplifier that powers it all using HDMI connections. The new center speaker at bottom surrounded by the baskets that hold the CD's. Made sure the CD's were in the baskets before The Boys confiscated them.



Consolation prize for The Boys is their own lawn. They didn't quite know what to do with the grass but Paul figured it out quickly and Peter soon after.
