Like the 13th and 15th Amendments during post-Civil War Reconstruction, the 14th Amendment was narrowly tailored and adopted for benefit of former slaves and their families. None of these three Reconstruction Amendments were ever intended to be applied to anyone else. This is easily confirmed by reading the arguments pro and con during the time it was established. True "birthright Citizen" and "natural born Citizen" are synonymous terms. 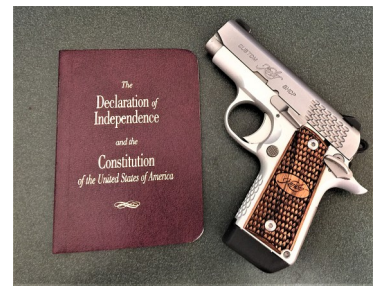
Constitution empowers Congress alone to "make laws"

in Article I Section 1:

"All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives."

No matter what opinion any court might issue, it's not a law, according to the Constitution and there are only two constitutional justices remaining on the Supreme Court as of 2026, Thomas and Alito. Three justices should never have been confirmed to the high court due to their open disdain for the Charters of Freedom and Rule of Law; Jackson, Kagan and Sotomayor. Kavanaugh and Barrett swing with the "deep state" political winds, not about what's legal or constitutional.

Gorsuch is often the swing-vote on the court, unpredictable at times. Alito wrote that the decision in Trump v. Barbara is "one of the most important decisions in the history of the Court, and in my judgment, the Court has made a serious mistake." As interpreted by the Court, the Fourteenth Amendment confers citizenship on virtually everyone who happens to be born in this country, including the children of "birth tourists," women who come here solely for the purpose of giving birth to a child and then return home. Careful analysis of the text of the Fourteenth Amendment and the history that led to its adoption shows that it does not degrade the concept of United States citizenship in this way. The Fourteenth Amendment confers citizenship on only those children who, at birth, owe allegiance solely to this country and not the one they return to after birth.



The Bill of Rights protects speech, religion, the press, assembly, due process, privacy, and the right to keep and bear arms. Only one of those rights has an entire federal agency built around regulating, restricting, investigating, and prosecuting the tools necessary to exercise it. The Second Amendment. That agency is the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

There is no federal Bureau of Speech. No federal Bureau of Religion. No federal Bureau of Press and Assembly. No federal agency licenses newspapers before they publish, inspects churches for recordkeeping violations, registers printing presses, or forces Americans to pay a tax before exercising a First Amendment right.

But when it comes to the Second Amendment, they have built exactly that kind of bureaucracy. Just what are they afraid of? And maybe they should be?

The term "anchor baby" is a label used to describe children born in countries with unrestricted birthright citizenship (jus soli) to non-citizen parents, but no country (***except the US***) has laws specifically creating "anchor babies", except those interpreted by SCOTUS.

The Center for Immigration Studies estimates that 30,000 to 40,000 babies are born annually in the U.S. to foreign women engaging in birth tourism, with China cited as a primary country of origin. Some agencies in China claim the number of Chinese nationals delivering babies in the U.S. exceeds 50,000 per year, while a 2012 Chinese government source cited 10,000 births in that specific year.

Hospitals in the U.S. are offering "birth packages" of up to \$5,000 to foreigners to help them give birth in border states like Texas, allowing their children to be born as U.S. citizens following the new SCOTUS ruling.

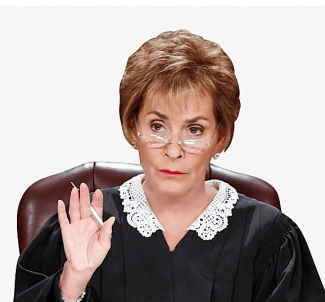
On the flip side, there are currently 19 foreign born voting members of congress with 17 in the House and two in the Senate. If you include members who are children of immigrants (born in the U.S. to at least one immigrant parent), the total rises to 80 voting members. None are anchor babies. However, it is fair to question their allegiance, specially if they hold dual citizenship. The Dual Loyalty Disclosure Act seeks to mandate that candidates reveal any non-U.S. citizenship, highlighting the current information gap. Until such laws pass or officials voluntarily report their status, the exact number remains unknown and unverified but are estimated to be as high as a dozen.

Note: Kamala Harris' parents were NOT citizens of the US when she was born. She is an anchor baby and NOT eligible for the highest office. *Ooops!*
