



MORE Election Fraud

Follow-up to the Lipitor story:

Merck has received FDA approval for Lipfendra, approved to reduce LDL cholesterol in adults with “high” LDL (the bad one). The list price is \$315 per 30-day supply (\$3,780 annually).

Lipitor is available as a widely used generic (atorvastatin), costing \$58 per month (or often less with insurance/ discounts).

Lipitor is a statin. It works inside liver cells to block the enzyme responsible for cholesterol, thereby reducing the amount of the liver makes.

Lipfendra is a peptide inhibitor. It works outside liver cells. This prevents the destruction of LDL receptors on the liver surface, allowing the liver to clear significantly more existing LDL cholesterol from the bloodstream.

The American Heart Association (AHA) and the American College of Cardiology (ACC) set the primary guidelines for acceptable LDL levels in the United States, recommending levels below 100 mg/dL for the general population and below 70 mg/dL for those with known cardiovascular disease.

As I mentioned in The Frank Report 7.18.2026 newsletter, how much is “bad”? In 1960, the level was 300. Then it was 240. Then it was 200.

Now it’s as low as 70. Every time that number was lowered, another 50 million Americans “needed” the drug. That’s not medicine...that’s marketing. Pfizer has made \$125 Billion selling Lipitor.

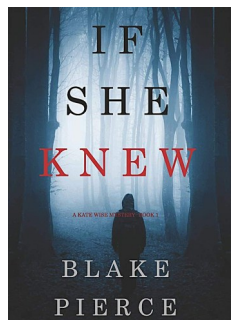

Book Report (special edition)

This was a free eBook from Amazon from an author new to me. It was a fast read and very entertaining. When I dug into the author's bio, I discovered why Amazon is giving his/her books away...



...to get you hooked on one of the many in the series... and it's many! I've ordered another free one from him/her noted as the most popular. I'll let you know after I read a few more. In the meantime, here's the background on what's going on...

With 217 books on the current lists, Blake Pierce is actually a bank of ghost writers. There are about 10+ writers that write under that name. You can research it and find the publisher has it registered this way. It's called Book Packaging. Even with 10 writers that is still over 21 books per year. Clive Cussler and James Patterson started this. You can spot the plot formula they use. Steve Berry isn't prolific but he also uses a plot formula. Lee Child's *Reacher* series adopted it half way through his series and even turned it over to his brother with the latest being so bad I didn't even finish it. (not so hidden judgement).

Note the column on first page about Alan. He was an underwear model before being cast in the series. Would the Lame Stream Media have been interested if he wasn't cast as *Reacher*? I didn't know he had a movie scheduled. It is aimed at the very audience he pissed off. Wonder if he invested in it?
