Checking the two websites, **Pratt** will crack
down on fraud, support law enforcement and
make sure laws are enforced fairly,
responsibly and consistently. **Little** will cut ICE

replacing ICE. He also supports raising taxes
on corporations and high-earners.

Pratt has a degree in Economics and an
MBA in Finance from the University of St.
Thomas. His career in banking and business
included Target and U.S. Bank and was
elected to the Minnesota Senate in 2012.

Little is a lawyer and former member of the
MN Senate. He was elected to the Senate in
2016 but lost reelection in 2020. After his
time in the legislature, he ran for Dakota Cty
Attorney in 2022 but lost to Kathy Keena.

Pratt's campaign has raised \$511,213 since he
announced his candidacy. As of July 20,
Pratt had \$254,372 in cash on hand.

Little has raised over \$900,000 since
announcing his candidacy but has only
\$127,543 in cash on hand as of July 20.
